- Third year students have computer 'c' programming practical as SBC in the V semester, so that they are trained to operate computers not only for programming purposes but also for preparing project reports and teaching materials for class room seminars with LCD projector.
- The third year students in their 6 semester are encouraged to study environmental studies. From this, they gain knowledge about the pollutants, their causes and methods of protecting the environment from major causes/diseases.
- The syllabus is framed to satisfy the state council rules of Tamil Nadu Govt. and for the choice based credit system .Total no. of credits given to each student in 140 for U.G.
- The Non major elective (NME) papers offered to the students are (i) AstroPhysics and (ii) Types of Energy and their utilization.



- ❖ In regular classes students are given a number of class tests to get through with the subject.
- ❖ Monthly tests and model tests are conducted as per university pattern.

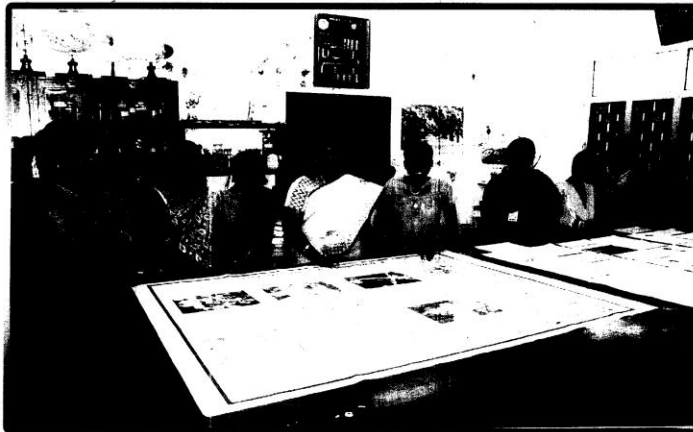

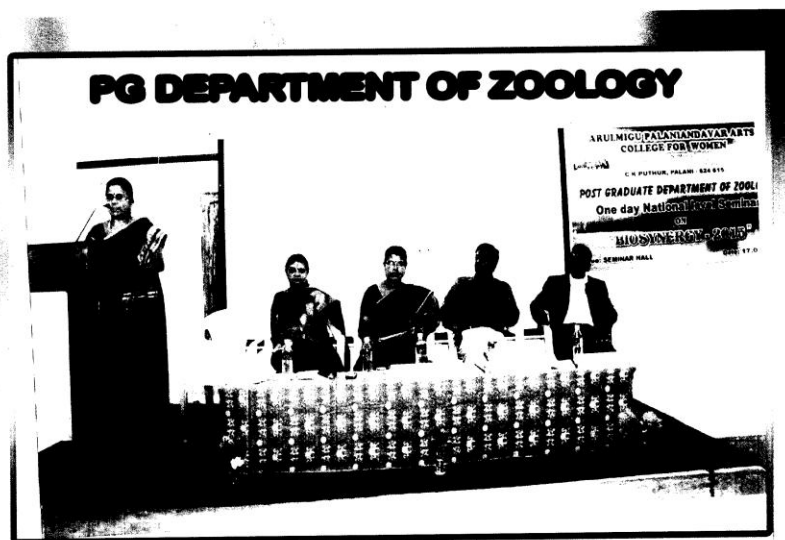
