Policy on Award of Scholarships and Freeships

Aim:

Arulmigu Palaniandavar Arts College for Women, Palani facilitates scholarships and freeships to the students with the aim to encourage the latter for better academic performance. The institution is resolved that no student will be deprived of education due to financial barrier.

Policy:

The institution facilitates Scholarships and Freeships to the students under the following categories:

- Utilizing the Scholarships provided for the students in different categories
- Making Institutional Freeships available to needy

Mission - I: Facilitating Scholarships, Provided by the Government:

The learners of this institution hail from interior villages and from economically backward conditions. The institution's primary mission is lessening the financial burden, created to the parents / guardian in educating their daughter / ward. The types are Scholarships and Freeships made available are listed below:

- BC / MBC / Other Minority Scholarship, awarded by Dept. of Backward Class Welfare, Govt. of Tamil Nadu to the students of Other Backward Classes
- SC / ST Scholarship, awarded by Dept. of Adi Dravida Welfare, Govt. of Tamil Nadu to the students of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe. This service is extended to the students in the self-financing stream also.
- Tamilnadu Adidraavidar Welfare Higher Education Special Scholarship / Loan Scheme to the students of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe. This service is extended to the students in the self-financing stream also.

Mission - II: Facilitating Scholarships, Provided by the Government:

The State Government of Tamil Nadu has launched a Scheme titled "Puthumai Penn" (New Woman). Students who have their schooling in Tamil Medium in Government schools are eligible to avail this scheme. Such selected students are provided with Rs. 1000/- every

month as a financial aid for their academics.

The college has appointed a Nodal Officer to facilitate this financial help, extended by the Government available to the students who fall in this category.

Mission - III: Providing Institutional Freeships – Free Breakfast Scheme:

The college is run under the aegis of the Hindu Religious and Charitable Trust, undertaken by the State Government of Tamil Nadu. The Administration of the college functions with the noble cause of educating and empowering the women students. Since 2022, the decision has been taken by the college Administration to fulfill one of the basic needs of the learners – providing nutritious food to them. 500 students are given the chance to utilize this service. The expenses are met out from the Arulmigu Dhandayuthapani Swamy Thirukkoil Charity Fund.

Mission - IV: Providing Institutional Freeships – Financial Support to Sports Persons

The college has created a wondrous track of winning in Sports and Games. The Sports Quota Allotment is strictly adhered to in admission. Students coming under the Sports Quota Category, if need arises, are provided Tuition and Special Fee Payment by the members of the Trust out of humanity.

Mission - V: Providing Proficiency Prizes:

Every year, the best academic and extra-curricular performers are awarded with proficiency prizes and certificates. This expense is met out from the Endowment Fund, created by the well-wishers of the institution. In addition, the faculty of the college contribute and sponsor medals and prizes to the best performers.
