On 18<sup>th</sup> September 2019, an awareness programme on Jal Shakhi Abhiyan was organized by the National Service Scheme units of Arulmigu Palaniandavar Arts College for Women, Palani. The Special team from the Ministry of Defence, Government of India addressed the gathering. 




